AN ANALYSIS OF CAMPAIGN EXPENDITURES IN  
OPPOSITION TO PROPOSITION 5

## **INTRODUCTION**

During the 1998 campaign season, dozens of news articles were written about the fact that Proposition 5 (Indian Gaming Compacts) had broken all previous records for spending on an initiative: all told, more than \$92 million.<sup>1</sup> The vast majority of the media coverage<sup>2</sup> focused on the substantial expenditures of California's Indian tribes in support of Proposition 5: \$66,257,088 to be precise.<sup>3</sup> Very much less was written about the nature of the opposition to Proposition 5. In previous years, any group that spent in excess of \$25 million dollars on an initiative would have been big news, but "No on 5" forces were given little scrutiny. This study aims to correct that imbalance.

This report shows that the opposition to Proposition 5 consisted of a few very well financed special interests: labor unions,<sup>4</sup> casinos (California and

Nevada), horse racing tracks, card clubs, and The Walt Disney Company. This stands in sharp contrast to the image that the “No on 5” coalition tried to convey—that of active citizen organizations concerned about the effect of gambling on their communities.<sup>5</sup> Furthermore, this report shows that these interests did not limit their involvement in California politics to direct contributions to “No on 5” committees. There is a long paper trail of expenditures to California elected officials over the course of several years, followed by a flurry of independent expenditures against the initiative as the November election approached.

### ***SUPPORTERS OF NO ON 5 COMMITTEES***

On the following page is a listing of those individuals or organizations who contributed directly to the three “No on 5” committees: *Coalition Against Unregulated Gambling*;<sup>6</sup> *Stand Up for California No on 5*; and *No on 5/Yes on 7, a Project of the Planning and Conservation League*.

This analysis shows that no California Indian tribes, law enforcement organizations, or religious organizations gave \$10,000 or more to the Coalition

Against Unregulated Gambling (CAUG), which was the primary committee that opposed Proposition 5. CAUG was dominated entirely by Nevada casinos, which stand to gain from reduced Indian competition, and by other organizations such as California casinos and businesses that benefit from strong Nevada gaming, and which have an economic interest in preventing competition from the expansion of Indian casinos.

Without exception the out-of-state interests would appear to benefit from preventing competition to Nevada casinos. All of the Nevada-based interests are casinos and casino executives. The other out-of-state interests are less obvious, but they also have an economic stake in keeping Nevada gaming strong. The Aztar Corporation, despite being based in Arizona, runs the Tropicana Resort in Las Vegas. The Perini Building Company, based in Framingham, Massachusetts, has built large Las Vegas casinos, among them the Luxor, the Caesar's Palace northern expansion, and the newly-opened Paris.

The picture of the California-based interests is not so clear-cut. Some California-based interests also benefit from Nevada gaming: A.G. Spanos owns a real-estate development company, which is a major developer of apartment dwellings in Las Vegas, where new hotel and casino workers tend to reside when they first move to the city.<sup>7</sup> He also has several developments in Henderson, Nevada, a short distance from Las Vegas. The Hilton Hotels Corporation owns

the Flamingo Hilton and the Hilton Hotel and Casino in Las Vegas, as well as a Hilton casino in Reno. Other California-based interests compete with Nevada gaming. The California Commerce Club, Inc. runs a casino in Commerce, California, under the current restrictions permitted by California law. Dennis J. Sammut owns the California-based casino Artichoke Joe's. Such California-based casinos, of course, share with Nevada interests a common fear of the expansion of Indian gaming.

In spite of its name, CAUG does not represent a large coalition of varied interests. Even labor is missing from this list. Only in *Stand Up for California No on 5* does any labor organization register \$10,000 or more in direct contributions; although, as this study will further document, labor contributed extensively to the "No on 5" effort through a series of campaign contributions to officeholders and through independent expenditures.

Perhaps the most interesting aspect of Table 1, however, is not who provided support to CAUG, but where those supporters reside. Looking down the list, one notices that few of the contributors are California-based organizations. Indeed, only 22.35 percent of itemized contributions were made by California companies (\$6,560,000 out of \$29,345,000).

### **OFFICEHOLDER ACCOUNTS<sup>8</sup>**

The Proposition 5 campaign likely would have been unnecessary had the Nevada gaming interests and their California allies been less successful in influencing California state legislators against the Indian tribes. Under the federal Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988 (IGRA), Indian tribes can only engage in the type of gaming permitted to anyone under the laws of the states in which they are based, and certain types of “Nevada-style” gaming can only be instituted if the tribes sign a compact with the Governor, subject to ratification by the legislature. The United States Supreme Court ruled<sup>9</sup> prior to IGRA that, absent any federal law to the contrary, tribes generally could conduct gaming on their lands without the need for a compact with the states. IGRA was a response to this ruling. Indians argue that IGRA was an unnecessarily restrictive piece of legislation that was pushed by Nevada and New Jersey gaming interests to limit competition from Indian tribes.<sup>10</sup> In effect, IGRA gives each state a veto over the

power of an otherwise sovereign political entity. Nevertheless, IGRA established the legal context in which Indian gaming operates, and thus gave the state legislatures considerable power over the matter.

Indeed it was in the Sacramento legislature that labor unions made their presence felt, alongside Nevada's interests. From January 1, 1995 to the November 3, 1998 election, these anti-Indian gaming interests gave substantial sums to California officeholders, among them:

- Dan Lungren, former Attorney General and candidate for Governor in 1998
- Bill Lockyer, State Senator and current Attorney General
- John Burton, current Senate Majority Leader
- Ross Johnson, Senate Republican Leader
- Antonio Villaraigosa, Assembly Speaker

- Ken Maddy, State Senator and owner of Maddy Racing Stables, and investor in Full House Resorts and the Pacific Racing Association
- Valerie Brown, former Assemblywoman and Chair of the Governmental Organization Committee in the 1997-98 term
- Bob Hertzberg, Assemblyman and contender to succeed Villaraigosa to the Speakership
- Gil Cedillo, Assembly Assistant Majority Leader, and possible alternative to Bob Hertzberg to ascend to the Speakership

gaming at all without explicit congressional authority. The Nevada gaming industry supported the 1988 law and hired superlawyer Robert S. Strauss to work for its passage.”



- Sheila Kuehl, Assemblywoman and Chair of the powerful Judiciary Committee
- Dick Floyd, Assemblyman and member of the Labor and Employment Committee, which would have jurisdiction over conflicts between Indians and labor leaders
- Ed Vincent, Assemblyman and Chair of the Select Committee on the California Horse Racing Industry
- Carole Midgen, Assemblywoman and member of the Select Committee on the California Horse Racing Industry
- Helen Thompson, Assemblywoman and member of the Assembly's Select Committee on Indian Gaming

Nevada interests alone contributed over \$3,000,000 to the various committees controlled by these candidates (including leadership committees).<sup>11</sup> A detailed chart of the contributions to the above-listed individuals follows on pages 10 through 22.

Indian gaming did not do terribly well in the 1997-98 term. In particular it suffered from Bill Lockyer's SB8, which increased the regulation of gambling within California, and stiffened the penalties for violations of California gaming regulations. In the Assembly, this bill was sponsored by Assemblywoman Helen Thompson. Gaming tribes suffered another setback from Sen. John Burton and Sen. Ken Maddy's bill to accept the Pala Gaming Compact, negotiated by the Wilson Administration with a tribe having no gaming operations. The Pala Compact not only settled for much less than Proposition 5 sought to achieve, but even required the tribes to submit to union organizers in a manner far surpassing what a private employer was required to do under the National Labor Relations Act. Finally, a number of bills, among them the Burton/Maddy bill, sought to authorize the Governor to act as the agent of the state in negotiating the compacts, with full knowledge that then-Governor Pete Wilson was opposed to increased gaming. This provision was eventually accepted in the Lockyer/Thompson bill.

#### INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES

The above donations are fairly easy to track: one merely analyzes the campaign statements of the relevant officeholders. Campaign finance analysis gets more complicated, however, in the realm of independent expenditures. There is no single compilation of all independent expenditures for or against a

particular candidate or initiative; the only way in which to pursue this means of analysis is to determine which individuals or committees are *likely* donors, and then obtain their donor statements. Obviously this approach is not flawless, for there will be an occasional individual or group that will make independent expenditures, but who did not contribute directly to the related committees. One example is the Los Angeles County Council on Public Education (COPE), an affiliate of the California Labor Federation. COPE was extraordinarily active in opposition to Proposition 5 in the final few months of the campaign. Labor unions in general were opposed to Indian gaming, because, as noted, Indian casinos are not required to apply the National Labor Relations Act guidelines as other private employers are. Indeed, many tribes refused to bargain with the unions. However, COPE never gave directly to CAUG by means of campaign contributions. On the following page is a table detailing the independent expenditures against Proposition 5 as reported by COPE.<sup>12</sup> After perusing these COPE documents, one can trace \$611,899.27 of expenditures made directly against Proposition 5, representing 42.09 percent of the total expenditures of COPE (\$1,453,659.63). Of course, one cannot split such expenditures out so simply. Should other independent expenditures on behalf of candidates be

considered, at least to some degree, as attempts to influence those candidates' positions on Proposition 5? For example, COPE spent \$523,999.55 in independent expenditures and direct contributions money in 1998 to elect Gray Davis governor. How much of that total should be considered part of the effort to influence Davis' thinking on Indian gaming? (Davis was officially neutral on Proposition 5.) After all, more than 42 percent of COPE's budget stems from anti-Indian gambling interests:

Should nearly 75 percent of COPE's expenditures then be considered devoted to the defeat of Proposition 5? Precise analysis may be impossible, but the link between Nevada gambling interests and labor unions is amply demonstrated in their joint attack on Proposition 5.

Other entities that were active in making independent expenditures to oppose Proposition 5 were: California Commerce Club, Inc. (\$7500 for legal services); Hilton Hotels Corporation (\$25,000 for legal services); Mirage Resorts (\$25,000 for legal services); Hotel Employees & Restaurant Employees Local 11 (\$50,175.11 over the final fifteen days of the campaign); Voter Improvement Program Ballot Measures Committee (\$134,189.08 over the same period); Labor '98 – California Labor Federation (\$38,058.25); and Workers' Rights Protection Fund of the California Labor Federation (\$5,750).<sup>14</sup>

#### PROPOSITION 5 POSTSCRIPT

Of course, in 1999 the California Supreme Court, entertaining a lawsuit filed by the unions and Las Vegas-backed interests, threw the issue of Indian gaming back to the elected officials.<sup>15</sup> Once again interests could be pressed with campaign contributions, and indeed they were. The table on the following page details campaign contributions from anti-Indian gaming forces to Governor Gray Davis, Attorney General Bill Lockyer, Speaker Antonio Villaraigosa, and Senate

Majority Leader John Burton. Gray Davis took in nearly \$200,000 in contributions from “No on 5” interests; and Bill Lockyer took in \$33,500. The real effort, however, was directed at the legislative leaders. John Burton took in 11.07 percent of his total receipts from “No on 5” interests, and Antonio Villaraigosa received nearly 16 percent of his contributions from those same interests.

## CONCLUSION

This study has shown that the vast majority of spending against Proposition 5 came from out of state. It also shows that Nevada interests and labor unions made massive candidate contributions to key officials. It may be particularly noteworthy that both Attorney General Dan Lungren and Attorney General candidate Bill Lockyer took copious sums of money from Nevada’s gaming industry, despite the fact that regulation of gaming falls under the jurisdiction of the Attorney General’s office.

There was little media coverage of the fact that Proposition 5 drew huge expenditures from Nevada and from labor unions. Almost no effort was made, even in the so-called quality media, to penetrate behind the veil of CAUG, to show that it was not funded by religious and other citizen organizations, but financed primarily by out-of-state interests. Even today, long after the full reports on campaign receipts first became available, the coverage remains decidedly one-sided. The prestigious *California Journal*, for example, concludes

that “voters were generally aware of the interest groups involved” in the campaigns for and against Proposition 5<sup>16</sup> and, in discussing contributions, notes that “California Indians augmented the proposition campaign with another, huge \$5 million investment in backing political candidates.”<sup>17</sup> The report makes no mention of the more than \$4.5 million in candidate “investments” of the Nevada casinos, labor unions and commercial interests hostile to Indian gaming.
